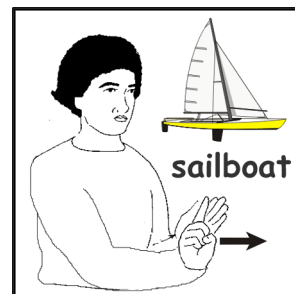
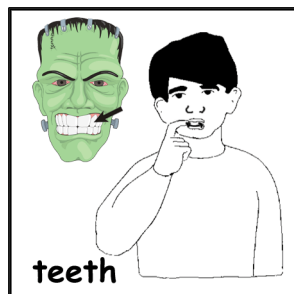
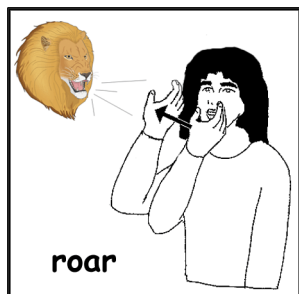
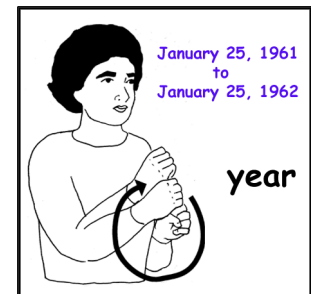
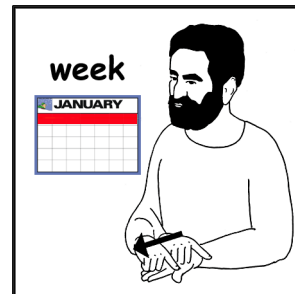
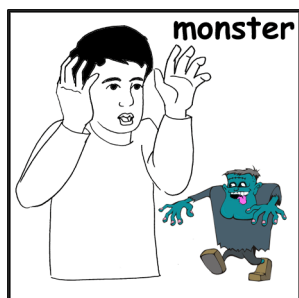


What Time Is It, Mr. Wolf? (Game)

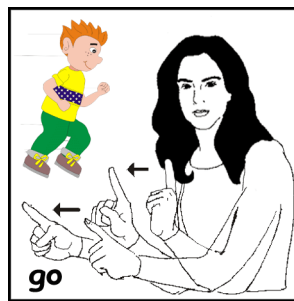
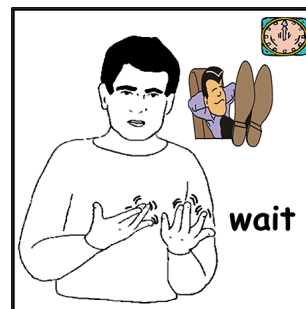
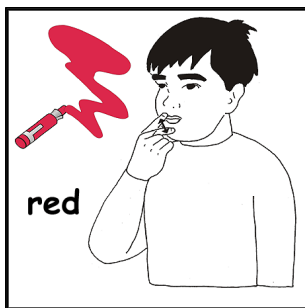
Red Light, Green Light/Red Light Rhyme

Yellow means slow

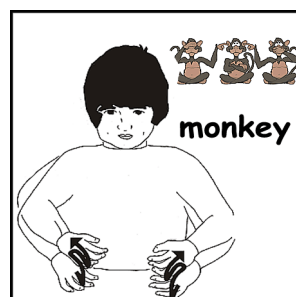
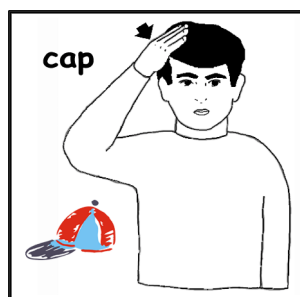

Friendship Sign Song

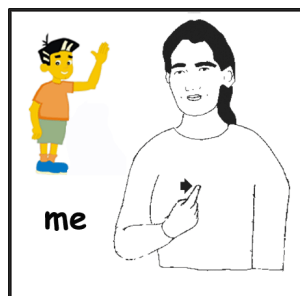
