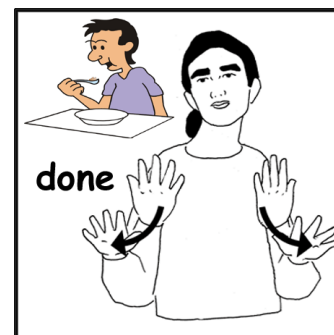


5 Pumpkins Feelings Song

(to the tune of “One Elephant Went Out to Play”)

One (feeling) PUMPKIN rolled out one night

(MORE PUMPKIN come-on gesture)

More ways to use this song with kids:

- 1) Make pumpkin magnet board pieces and laminate them, but don't draw the faces on yet. Invite the children to suggest emotions for each verse, and use a dry erase marker to draw the faces as you go. Ask the children to describe facial expressions that go with the various feelings.
- 2) Print and cut out enough pumpkins to give one to each child. Ask them each to select an emotion and draw a facial expression that goes with it. You may also want to write (or have them write) the name of the emotion on the back of the pumpkin for writing practice. Then invite each child to put their pumpkin on the board as you sing the song.
